Question #1 • Text Response • 15 responses (88%)
What are the instructor's teaching strengths?

Results:

- Yunlong Cao is a very effective teaching assistant. The main strengths are clarity, patience, and the ability to explain challenging material in a way that feels approachable. Section was always organized and focused, and the environment felt open and supportive, making it easy to ask questions or work through confusion without feeling pressured. The guidance provided during section and in feedback helped me understand the expectations of the course and strengthened my ability to analyze and reconstruct arguments.
- Good at going with the flow tries to make sure that if students have questions, they can ask good at responding to emails good at creating supplemental discussion work
- He gives good feedback, explains the material in depth, and he is able to give clear instructions if the student doesn't understand the first time when doing an assignment

How can this instructor improve as a teacher?

Results:

- One possible improvement would be incorporating a bit more structured practice during section, such as doing a short argument reconstruction together or reviewing a sample response to show what strong work looks like. This would make the connection between lecture concepts and assignment requirements even more concrete.
- If the grades could come out earlier and we could get feedback sooner, this would be the greatest improvement. I am uncertain if this is to blame on the TA, however, as perhaps the class simply needs more manpower to grade the number of students faster.
- Speak more with the main instructor about expectations for the course. There was definitely a gap in communication between expectations and how to reach those expectations.
- I am not sure, the discussion sections kinda sucked because nobody went to them and they were online... I am not really sure if there is something that could be improved
- He can create a calendar of office hours where we are able to choose a date for office hours one day before, instead of 2 or 3 days before.
